Melbourne is a maze of hidden laneways, opulent bars, exclusive restaurants and off-the-beaten-track boutiques. Here you can soak up culture, hit the sporting grounds, taste the dynamic food and wine scene, dance till dawn or wander the parks and leafy boulevards.

MELBOURNE CITY TOUR

Spot as many seals as possible, sweet looking koalas, smart kangaroos at the respective wildlife parks.

GREAT OCEAN ROAD

Golden surf beaches and coastal cliffs are some of the major attraction along the Great Ocean Road. A drive around the vast trail lets you relax and unwind. The seaside city of Lorne with a Mediterranean feel and charming scenery is magical. Enjoy a local favorite, a fish and chips lunch in Apollo bay(own expense) and sit by the beach or wander a long the main street.

Travel through the Otway National Park, a region of evergreen rainforest with tree ferns and tall eucalyptus.

Travel around Gibson's steps to get a very different view of the dramatic limestone cliffs and spectacular rock stacks. Marvel at the stark stone pillars of the Twelve Apostles, Razorback, Island Arch and other twisted "stacks". Shipwrecks, a tragic part of this rugged coast, the most notable being the "Loch Ard". Descend into "Loch Ard" Gorge and have time to experience the magic of the shipwreck Coast. The dramatic scenery provides tremendous scope for photography.

PUFFING BILLY WITH BLUE DANDENONGS AND AUSTRALIAN WILDLIFE

Located just a short drive to the east of Melbourne, the beautiful Blue Dandenong Ranges are home to colorful native birds, fern gullies and tall mountain ash eucalyptus. Make a visit to the quaint mountain village of Sassafras. Tour through quaint mountain villages noted for their restaurants and craft shops. Purchase a couple or of craft pieces to carry home as souvenirs. Puffing Billy steam train-an original steam locomotive, Victoria's most unique attractions. You will delight to the sounds of the whistle and the steam as you ride Puffing Billy through the forest.

Healesville Sanctuary has the largest collection of Australian wildlife. You can walk through the bushland, talk to the keepers and observe native animals in their habitats.



BALLART GOLD TRAIL

For a more impacting town tour, join the trail including Lake Wendouree, journeying through the streets lined with stunning 19th century buildings, exquisite gardens, notable churches and the Eureka Stockade Centre, a state-of-the-art multimedia complex which brings to life the historic 1854

MOUNT BULLER

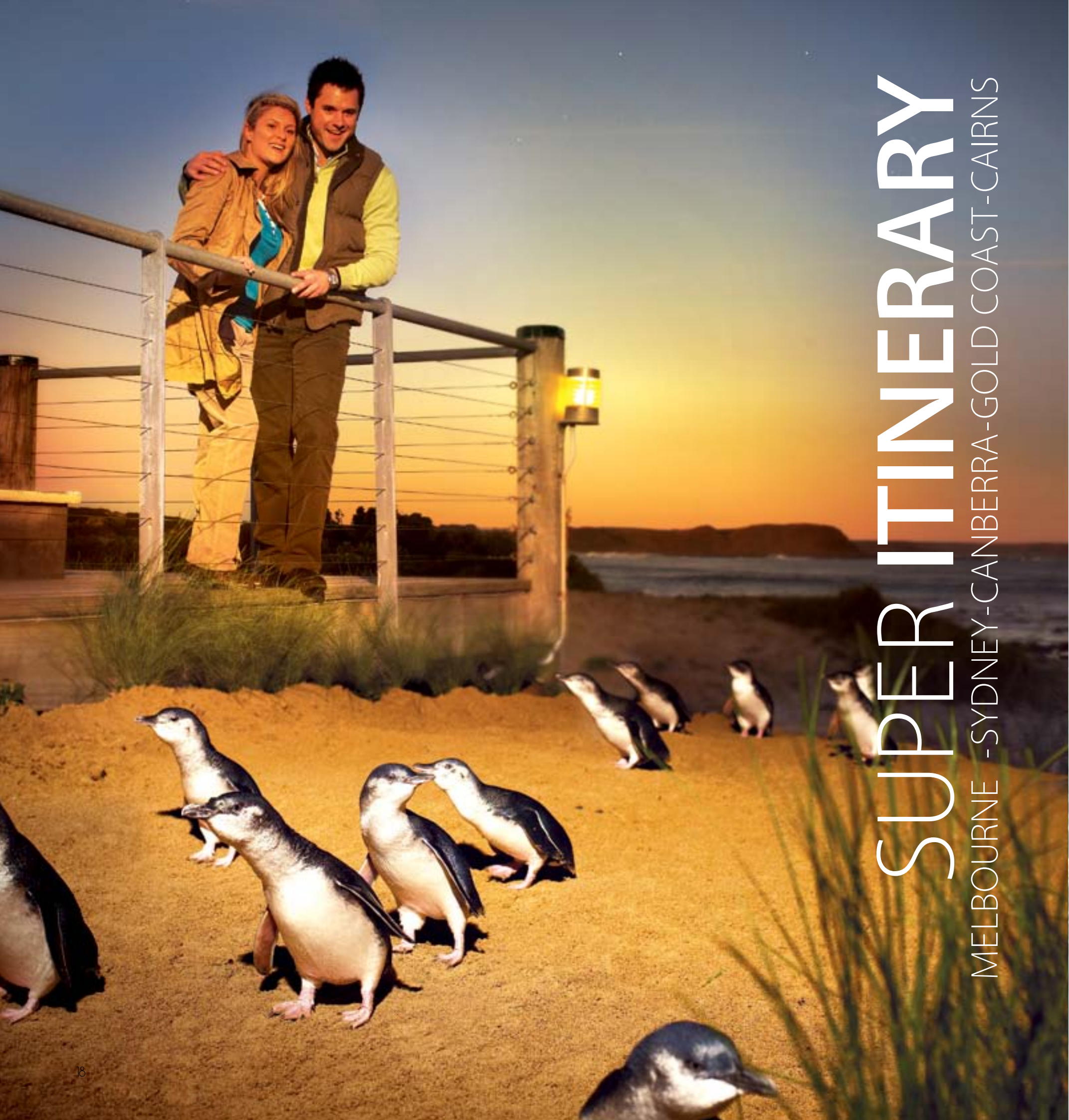

Proceed around Gibson's steps to get a very different view of the dramatic limestone cliffs and spectacular rock stacks. Marvel at the stark stone pillars of the Twelve Apostles, Razorback,

Island Arch and other twisted "stacks". Shipwrecks, a tragic part of this rugged coast, the most notable being the "Loch Ard". Descend into "Loch Ard" Gorge and have time to experience the magic of the shipwreck Coast. The dramatic scenery provides tremendous scope for photography. The day's trip winds by 1:00pm. the quaint mountain village of Sassafra. Back to the hotel by 01:00 PM. Following the lunch you may indulge in surfing the city, shopping centers, clubs on your own. Get ready to wake up early the next morning.

Activity 5: Be ready by 10:00 am after a good breakfast for the Yarra Valley Wineries Tour. Enjoy the bliss of the Yarra River, breathing in the fresh and reviving air. The rest of the rest of the day is spent by you in and around the hotel locality.

Activity 6: For a more impacting town tour be ready by 8:20 am. You’re shown around the Gold fields of Victoria, Ballarat being the main place of attraction. Join the trail including Lake Wendouree, journeying through the streets lined with stunning 19th century buildings, exquisite gardens, notable churches and the Eureka Stockade Centre, a state-of-the-art multimedia complex which brings to life the historic 1854 miners uprising. On to the Sovereign Hill which is an internationally renowned heritage park on the site of the richest alluvial gold rush in the world. You will have time to explore Red Hill Gully diggings, the Gold Museum and the fully operational township...wander down Main Street, ride a stagecoach, talk to the blacksmith, try some homemade sweets! Devonshire teas are available at the New York Bakery or a good hearty lunch at the United States Hotel (own expense).

The tour comes to a close for the day by 5.30pm. Get good rest and be ready for the next day’s trip.

Activity 7: For the Mount Buller Snow Day Tour be ready by 6.45am. Relaxing sunset picnics on the Summit to thrilling cross country mountain biking adventures and more are possible at Mt Buller. It offers a unique way to enjoy the alpine environment.

Activity 8: Be up and ready after breakfast by 8.00am for the Mornington Peninsula and Sorrento tour. Just a short drive south of Melbourne, the Mornington Peninsula has something for everyone. Fine food and wine, historic attractions, wildlife, bays and peninsulas and breathtaking views - let the Mornington Peninsula awaken your senses! On towards Sorrento, A popular beachside haven for locals and tourists alike, you’ll have plenty of time to discover this trendy township. Why not have your morning break at The Baths Cafe in Sorrento and enjoy its prime ‘front

beach’ location? Wander a little further to the main street and discover Sorrento’s historic buildings, galleries and boutique shops. Tour downtown Melbourne including Flinders street station, Docklands, tree-lined streets, shopping malls and arcades, trams, china town, law courts and high rise buildings. Followed by the lunch you may surf in the city on your own for shopping, museums, clubs, casinos, cafes on your

Activity 12: Following the breakfast proceed to and thrilling City Tour of Sydney. We travel via Darling Harbour and passing Sydney Entertainment Centre, Sydney Aquarium and Sydney Opera House. Tour through the Rocks - the birthplace of Sydney with its colorful and historic past. Other highlights includes the Botanic gardens, Parliament House, Hyde Park, Art Gallery and the Domain. Arrive at Mrs Macquaries Chair for a photo stop and witness the superb views of the city skyline, the Opera House, the Bridge and the Harbour. Continue the tour through Double Bay and Vaucluse, one of Sydney's most prominent suburbs and to the Gap for spectacular views of the Pacific Ocean. Bondi Beach is the Australia's most famous surf beach and we will take break to stroll along the beach front. Tour through Paddington, where you will see Sydney Tower and Sydney Town hall.

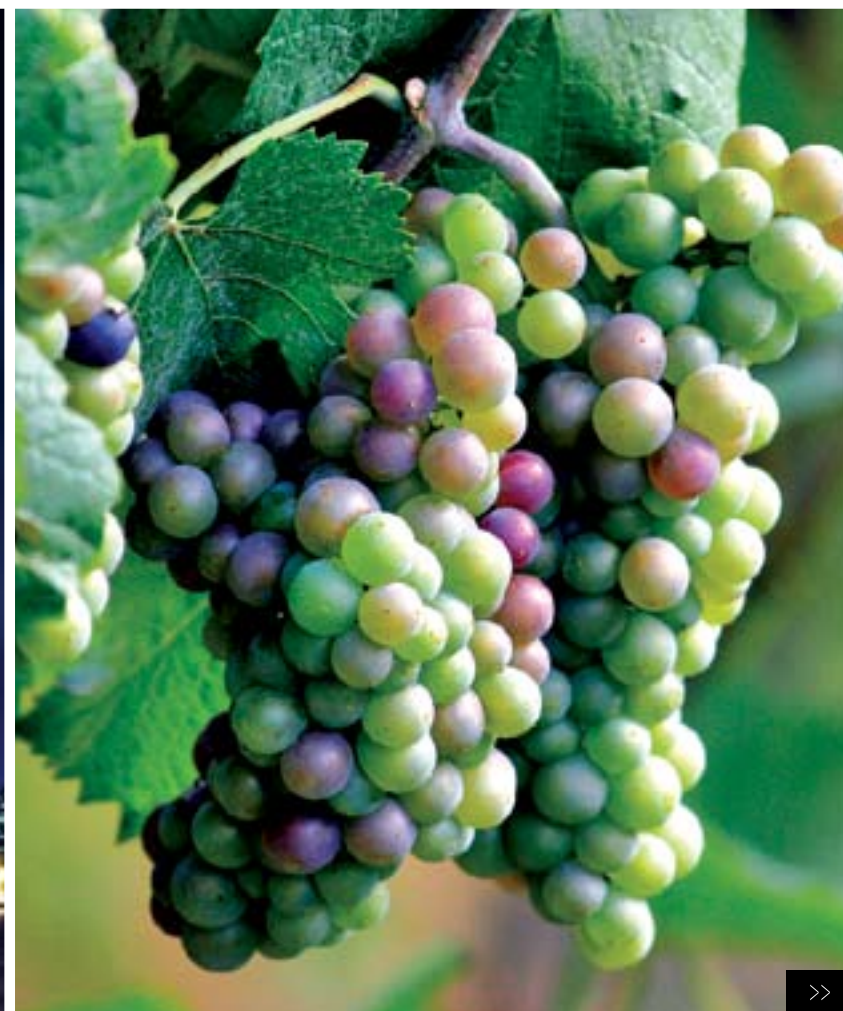
Experience Harbour Luncheon Cruise : - Enjoy a luncheon cruise on board the streamlined Captain Cook Cruises.

At Katoomba, witness breathtaking views over the Jamison and Megalong Valleys. See the Three Sisters, a giant rock formation relating to early Aboriginal legends. Ride the Scenic Skyway, Scenic Railway or Scenic Cableway (own expense).
